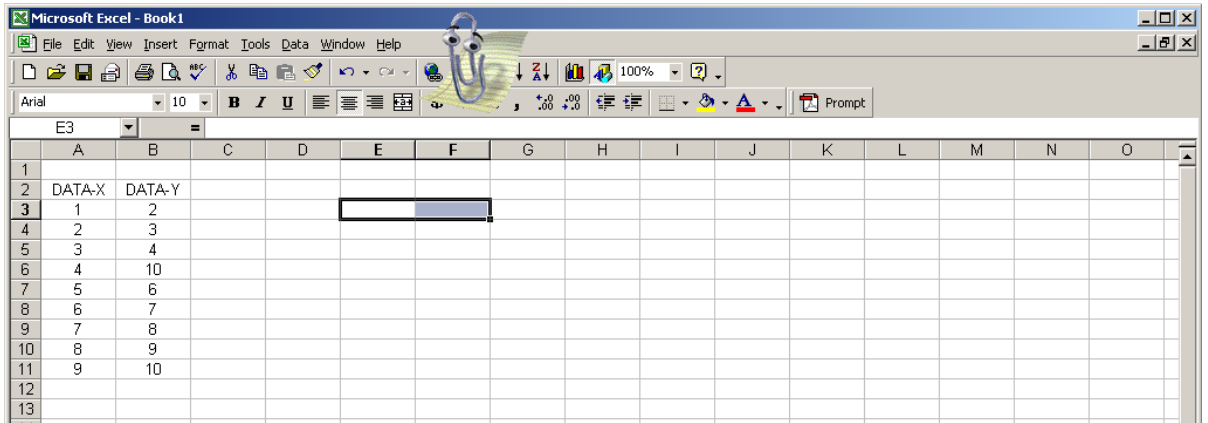
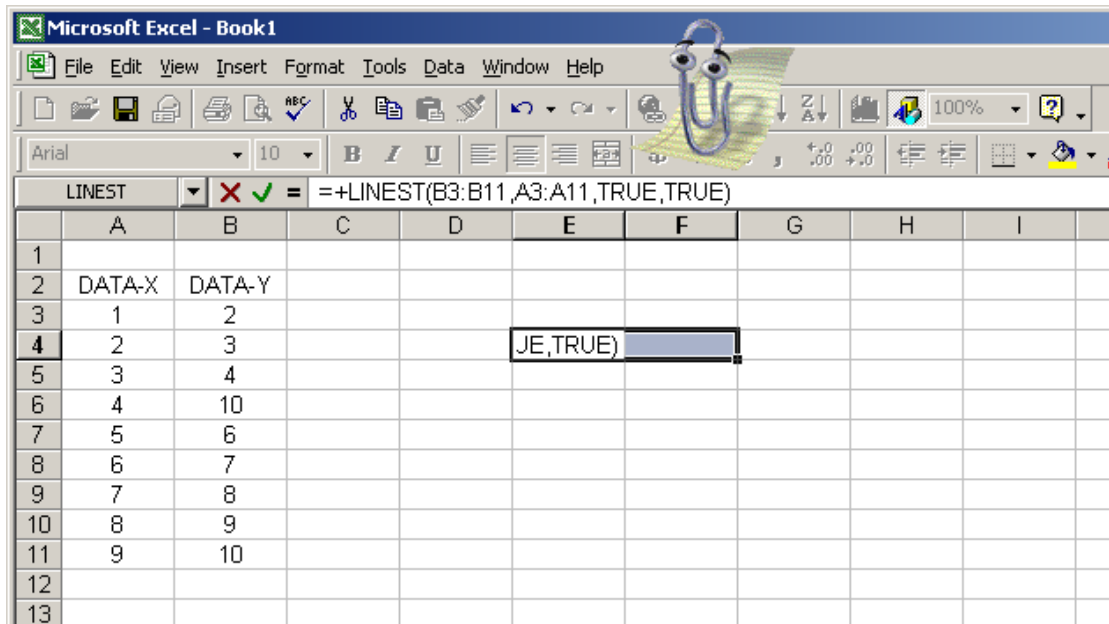


A) Using your mouse mark/select two cells in the same row




B) in the Equation space insert the formula (see below)
